## **Reach Conformity Declaration**

This Declaration is made by Secomea for the benefit of Secomea's customers.

We hereby declare compliance with the European Union's REACH regulation (Regulation No 1907/2006), which addresses the production and use of chemical substances and their potential impacts on human health and the environment.

At this time, Secomea is not aware of any products manufactured by Secomea would require substance registration and notification under REACH Articles 6 and 7.

REACH Article 33 (1) requires suppliers to inform the recipients if an article contains more than a concentration of 0.1% w/w (by weight per article) of any substance(s) on the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) Candidate List\*. The European Chemicals Agency released the latest candidate list of SVHC on June 25, 2020, bringing the total number of substances to 209. To the best of Secomea's knowledge, based on own research and feedback from suppliers, SVHC are not present in a concentration above 0.1% w/w in any of Secomea's products.

In addition to substances already restricted under EU's Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive, REACH Article 67 identifies certain substance restrictions in Annex XVII that might be present in electrical and electronic equipment. These substance restrictions, which are fewer in number than the SVHC list, also apply to distributors who resell components and subassemblies, and retailers who resell finished equipment. To the best of Secomea's knowledge, none of Secomea's products contain any substances subject to Annex XVII restrictions.
